Safari Tents

Double/Single Occupancy

Maximum capacity: 6 guests per tent

Layout (3 bedrooms per tent):

- 1 x Double bedroom sleeps 2
- 1 x Double cabin bed (up a short ladder) sleeps 2
- 1 x Bunk bedroom sleeps 2
- Optional: 1 x single camp bed (in den beneath the cabin bed) sleeps 1
 - if sharing a double is not an option

Total across all 5 Safari Tents: sleeps 30 guests

Single Occupancy

- 1 x Double bed sleeps 1
- 1 x Double cabin bed sleeps 1
- 1 x Bunk bedroom sleeps 2
- Optional: 1 x single camp bed (in den beneath the cabin bed) sleeps 1

Total across all 5 Safari Tents: sleeps 25 guests





Ranger Lodges

Double/Single Occupancy

Maximum capacity: 7 guests per tent Layout (3 bedrooms per tent):

- 1 x Double bedroom sleeps 2
- 1 x Double bedroom (up short outdoor stairs) sleeps 2
- 1 x Bunk bedroom with extra single bed sleeps 3

Total across both Ranger Tents: sleeps 14 guests

Single Occupancy

- 1 x Double bed sleeps 1
- 1 x Double bedroom (upstairs) sleeps 1
- 1 x Bunk bedroom with extra single bed sleeps 3

Total across both Ranger Tents: sleeps 10 guests









Shepherd Huts

Double Occupancy

Maximum capacity: 2 adults per hut

Layout: 1 x Double bed (adult-only accommodation) – sleeps 2

Total across all 3 Shepherd's Huts: sleeps 6 guests

Single Occupancy

Layout: 1 x Double bed (adult-only accommodation) – sleeps 1

Total across all 3 Shepherd's Huts: sleeps 3 guests









Exclusive use of onsite facilities

Groups booking exclusive use of Camp de Rêves have access to the following spaces and amenities — perfect for shared meals, meetings, and relaxed downtime together:

Oak Frame Barn:

Games Room & Multi-Purpose Space

- Usually filled with games and seating the room can also be used as a meeting room, rehearsal space, or dining area
- Flexible layout can be left open or set up with tables (to be pre-arranged)
- Kitchen facilities available for use by external caterers (to be pre-arranged)





Cooking facilities

Outdoor Kitchen & Dining Area

- 2 pizza ovens one wood-fired and one gas
- Large fire pit with Dutch oven and various components for group cooking
- Gas ring with large pots for preparing meals for big groups
- Plenty of outdoor seating, including covered dining areas for all-weather comfort







Outdoor play area & adjoining field

Children's play area

Pirate-themed adventure zone featuring a pirate ship, swings, climbing equipment, slide, seesaw, slackline, and a selection of outdoor games.

Large adjoining field

Ideal for team games, training sessions, yoga, or open-air group activities.

Pétanque pitch

Perfect for a relaxed game in the sunshine — sets provided with each accommodation.

Two washing machines and three tumble dryers available in the oak frame barn.

On-site café / shop:

Located in the oak frame barn, serving coffees, soft drinks, snacks, pizza dough & essentials. Freshly baked pastries can be pre-ordered the day before.

Spacious parking area with an EV charging point available for guest use.


