


Gentle, car-free Herm, one of the

Islands of Guernsey, is taking more steps to achieve carbon neutrality. Its ferry service from Guernsey now uses hydrotreated vegetable oil, made by Jersey supplier Rubis Channel Islands, and next up is the conversion of all boilers on the 0.77-squaremile island to 100 per cent renewable heating oil.

Herm is 20 minutes by sea from St Peter Port and has long stretches of white sand, cliff paths with views to the French coast and its own microclimate.


