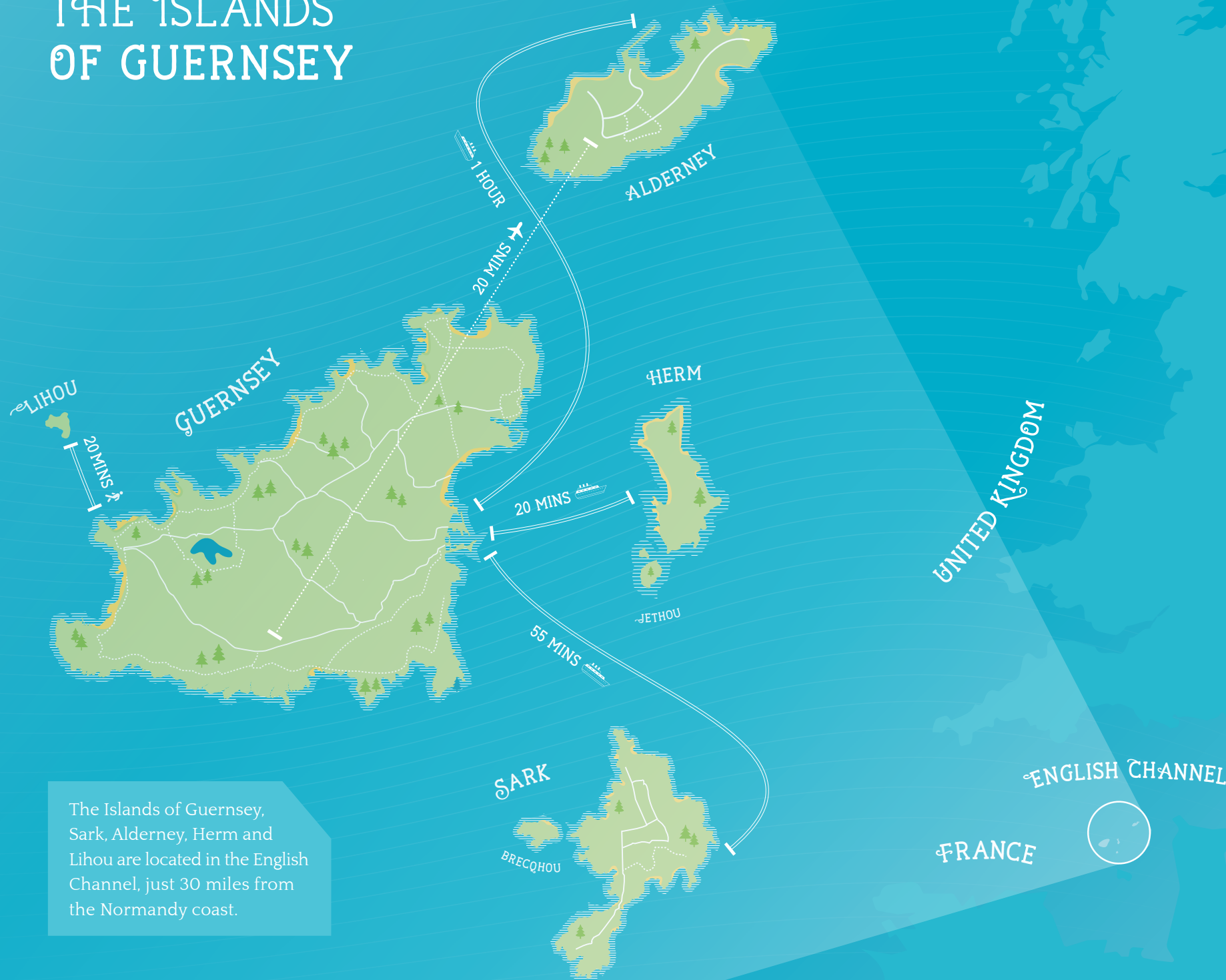

And as part of the British Isles, you won't need to bring your passport or use foreign currency either.

YOUR FIRST PORT OF CALL

Tiny in size but big on charm, St Peter Port is the capital of Guernsey.

Known colloquially by Islanders as 'town' and home to around 18,000, St Peter Port is a colourful display of flowers and bunting. There's a distinct Mediterranean feel and an abundance of charm, with steep cobbled streets snaking their way up the hillside, all set against the spectacular backdrop of the 800 year-old Castle Cornet.

At only three square miles, it's small but perfectly formed, with historic attractions, beaches and Victorian bathing pools all within walking distance of seafront restaurants, buzzing bars and independent boutiques.

THINGS TO DO IN ST PETER PORT



1. Candie Gardens
Historic gardens offering panoramic views across town to the neighbouring Islands.

2. Guernsey Museum & Art Gallery
Set in Candie Gardens where you can find out more about Guernsey's fascinating past.

3. La Vallette Bathing Pools
Recently renovated, the Pools look out across Guernsey's sister Islands and Castle Cornet.

4. La Vallette Underground Military Museum
Award-winning museum set in tunnels built by the Germans during the Occupation.

5. The National Trust of Guernsey Victorian Shop & Parlour
Step back in time at this restored 18th century shop.

6. Guernsey Tapestry
1000 years of Guernsey history is captured in 10 embroidered panels, created by the local community.

7. Le Petit Train
Take a trip around St Peter Port and see the sights on this novelty train.

8. German Naval Signals HQ
Headquarters of the German Naval Commander during the Occupation.

9. Hauteville House
Victor Hugo's Guernsey home, extensively renovated in 2019.

10. Castle Cornet
800-year old castle with museums. Visit at midday to watch the firing of the Noon Day Gun.

LOVING THY NEIGHBOUR IS EASY TO DO

Whether we're talking about the simplicity of Sark, the paradise of Herm, the wildlife haven of Alderney or the nature of Lihou, each Island is unique in its own right. So why visit just one when you can experience all five on day trips or overnight stays?

OUR GUIDE TO EXPLORING THE ISLANDS OF GUERNSEY

Step on a boat and 'sea' where it takes you.

Guernsey is a great launch pad from which to visit the sister Islands of Sark, Herm, Alderney and Lihou. Here is our guide to help you make the most of your stay.

Herm:

1. Travel Trident (traveltrident.com) operates a frequent ferry service, 364 days a year
2. 20 minute crossing
3. Purchase tickets from the Travel Trident kiosk or Guernsey Information Centre in St Peter Port

Top tip: During high season, an evening 'Dinner Boat' service runs for customers eating on Herm. Reservations must be made directly with either The Mermaid Tavern or The White House Hotel on Herm.

Sark:

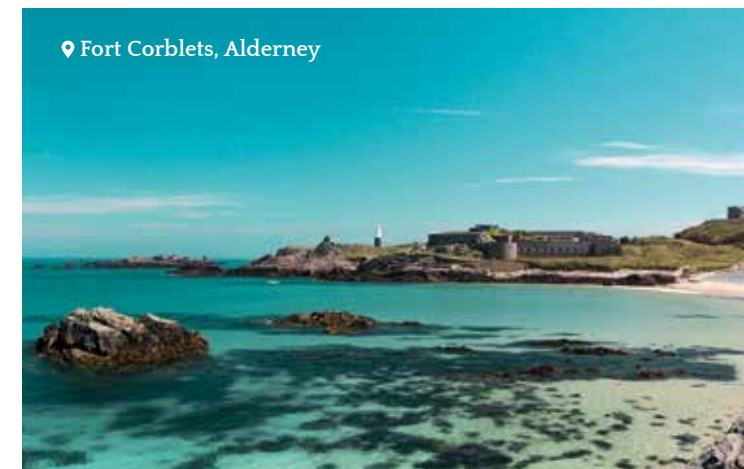
1. Ferries run throughout the year operated by the Isle of Sark Shipping Company (IOSS)
2. 55 minute crossing
3. Book online (sarkshipping.gg) or at the IOSS office at White Rock, St Peter Port Harbour

Top tip: There are no cash points on Sark so remember to take cash with you.

Alderney:

1. Ferries are operated by the Little Ferry Company, which runs twice daily services between May and September
2. 1 hour crossing
3. Book online a minimum of 30 minutes before departure at thelittleferrycompany.com

Top tip: Book in advance as spaces are limited, with only 12 tickets available for each trip.

Lihou:

1. Only accessible on foot at low tide. Tide timetables can be found online at gov.gg/lihou
2. Sturdy footwear is recommended as the path is often wet from the falling tide
3. Please note that dogs are not allowed on the Island

Top tip: Keep an eye on the time and don't miss the tide on the way back to Guernsey!

SIMPLY SARK

Wind down and live life in the slow lane.

Step off the ferry and back in time on the beautiful car-free Island of Sark. The Island is best seen by foot, bike or horse and carriage (yes, really) and the latter can be hired once you're there.

Exploring is well rewarded too. There are secluded bays to find, great places to eat and even an RHS-recommended garden at La Seigneurie to discover.

All this, while being surrounded by breathtaking scenery, the most dramatic of which is 'La Coupée', a narrow isthmus connecting Sark to Little Sark. A walk across is a must-do.

Sark also became the world's first Dark Sky Island, so if you're staying overnight and the conditions are right, you can look forward to a star-studded show.

HERM – PARADISE FOUND

Small but perfectly formed, there is no place like Herm.

As you arrive in Herm, gliding over crystal clear, turquoise water, it is easy to forget that you are, in fact, still in the English Channel and not somewhere a little more exotic. It's an illusion that only gets added to further as you start to explore, discovering the golden sands of unspoilt beaches.

On a hot day, and actually, on a not-so-hot day too, it doesn't take much to tempt in

swimmers and snorkelers, kayakers and paddle boarders, who share the water with the Island's wildlife.

The land itself is lush and green and coastal paths wind their way around high cliffs. As they rise and fall you can enjoy views over to Guernsey, Sark and the smaller Island of Jethou.

ALDERNEY AWAITS

Take a walk on the wild side on the most northerly Island.

The furthest away from Guernsey, Alderney is worth the hour-long ferry journey or short plane trip north. Distinctly wild and untamed, Alderney is home to an array of rare flora and fauna, including the unique blonde hedgehog, bats and black rabbits. Multiple species of wild seabirds nest in its waters, with an impressive 2% of the world's gannet population located in Alderney during nesting season.

Victorian forts and World War II fortifications dot Alderney's coastline, visible reminders of its rich history and strategic location close to northern France, along with the only train in the Channel Islands and one of the oldest in the British Isles. Now a popular tourist attraction, passengers can hop aboard for a two mile trip along the coast.

WILD LIHOU

An Island so exclusive, it is only open at certain times.

Knowing the tide times shouldn't feel like essential information to hold, but when you're on an Island that kind of knowledge can open up new avenues. And in some cases, literal avenues...

That's right, if you were to go to the L'Erée headland at low tide, you would see a cobbled pathway appearing from the water, snaking its way across the causeway, leading to the Island of Lihou.

Guernsey's closest neighbour is an unapologetically wild place, a Ramsar wetland site and a natural haven to over 150 species of bird. It is home to a ruined priory and the 'Venus Pool', a natural swimming pool formed in the rocks.

So whether you're making the 570m walk with binoculars or swimmers in hand, it's not going to disappoint. Just remember to check the tide times to get back!

From the amateurs to the pros, the Islands are perfectly set-up for cyclists. Whether it's Guernsey's 'Ruelle Tranquilles'; the network of rural routes where motorists are limited to 15mph or Sark's status as a car-free haven, cycling around the Islands is a world away from pedalling in a busy city.

There are 11 official Island tours from which to choose, ranging from six to 12 miles and for all ability levels, meaning you can explore the Islands' coasts, woodland and country lanes at your leisure. While it is possible to bring your own bike to Guernsey, if you are planning to move around, due to the size of some ferries, we recommend hiring once you've arrived on each Island. COME ON IN THE WATER'S FINE

Due to the Islands' climate, you can get soaked every day!

While the Islands are, of course, a place to relax and unwind, if you were looking for something to get the pulse racing a little more, you wouldn't need to go too far to find it. With crystal clear, turquoise-blue waters meeting rugged coastlines, our Islands make the ideal natural playground. Whether it's sea-kayaking, coasteering, surfing, paddle boarding or just enjoying a wild swim, it's the perfect place to dive right in.

You could be a seasoned veteran of the waves, looking to explore some ancient caves, or just keen to dip your toes into one of our many sheltered bays, there's an experience to be had no matter how much you want to be thrilled.



Did you know?

There are plenty of outdoor activity providers who offer different experiences for groups of all sizes.

Try the adrenaline rush of coasteering, a puffin-spotting tour around Herm by sea kayak, or a surf or SUP lesson in the Islands' perfect blue waters.

THERE'S NOT MUCH TO SEE AT NIGHT

The Islands are known as one of the best places in the world to stargaze, so nights here are never dull. For the very best vantage points to observe the glittering night sky, head to Guernsey's south coast, Herm, Alderney, or Sark, the world's first designated Dark Sky Island where you can watch a silver ceiling of stars at the volunteer-run observatory.

THE ISLANDS OF GOOD TASTE

Recently named the UK's gastronomic hotspot in the Good Food Guide, the Islands have almost 200 eateries from which to choose. Enough to leave you spoilt for choice, when heading out for a bite to eat.



YOU WON'T LEAVE HUNGRY

We're a diverse place and our food is no different.

As you relax in one of our picturesque harbour side cafés and restaurants, look out for fishermen bringing in their daily catch, ready to be cooked later that day, using local ingredients such as wild rock samphire and seaweed. We're equally known for what lives off our land, with the famous Guernsey cows producing the milk from which we make our award-winning butter and cheese.

With a multitude of eateries across the Islands, from beachside kiosks and cafés to market stalls, local pubs and high-end restaurants, there's plenty to choose from, no matter your taste or budget.



One of the refreshingly different and quirky aspects of Island life, is the presence of 'Hedge Veg' boxes located along roadsides and in the front gardens of private homes. With a variety of fresh ingredients including home-grown vegetables, eggs and even home-made jams and chutneys, this honesty box system is a great example of how friendly and trusting the locals are.

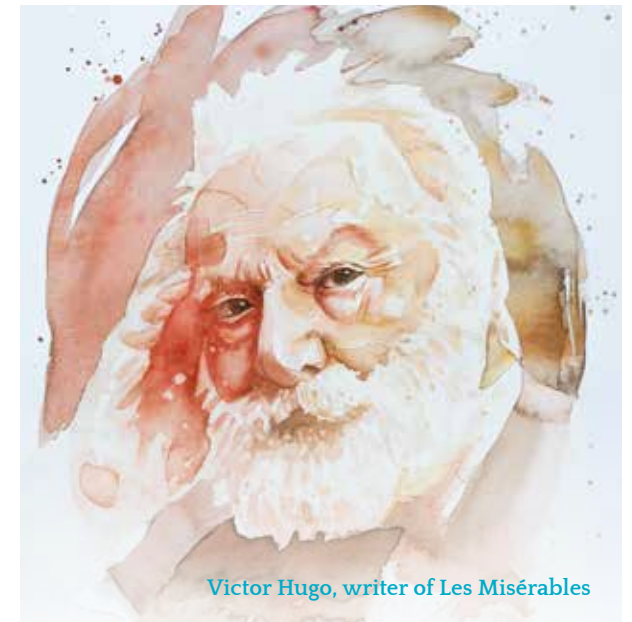

Victor Hugo, writer of *Les Misérables*

LES ÎLES D'INSPIRATION

The Islands of Guernsey. Influencing artists and writers since the 1800s.

Maybe it's the beautiful scenery, the sea air or perhaps just something in the water, but the Islands of Guernsey have been inspiring visitors for centuries. Perhaps the most notable being Pierre-Auguste Renoir, the French impressionist, and his compatriot, 'Les Misérables' writer Victor Hugo.

Hugo fell in love with Guernsey during his 15 years in exile, and wrote much of his most famous work here. His home during that time, Hauteville House, is a popular tourist attraction and was recently refurbished in 2019.

Renoir spent a month in St Peter Port in 1883 and enjoyed trips to Moulin Huet Bay and the surrounding hills, now famed by his work, where he produced 15 masterpieces of the area.



+ Did you know?

Perhaps the most famous book written by an Islander is 'The Book of Ebenezer Le Page' by GB Edwards. An acclaimed piece of literature, it has also been praised for its depiction of life on Guernsey in the 20th century.

One of fifteen paintings Renoir produced during his summer in Guernsey, it depicts three figures playing on the beach at Moulin Huet Bay, a scene still regularly seen to this day.



ISLAND HAVEN

It's no wonder residents, wildlife and plants alike love living here.

The Islands' natural beauty is clear to see all year round. The warmer, sub-tropical climate means plants thrive here, decorating our landscapes with vibrant colour. We're home to formal gardens and RHS award-winning grounds, as well as an abundance of wildflowers in our fields, hedgerows and cliff paths.



Our environment is unique, and our large tidal ranges create a diverse mix of habitats for wildlife, so much so it has earned us international recognition. The Islands have not one, but two Ramsar protected sites, which ensures conservation of those areas. Still accessible to visitors, these are Lihou Island and the surrounding wetlands as well as Herm, Jethou and the Humps.

The Occupation of the Islands of Guernsey by German forces inspired the 2008 best seller and subsequent film, 'The Guernsey Literary and Potato Peel Pie Society' written by Mary Ann Shaffer and Annie Barrows.

You can walk in the footsteps of the characters via guided tours, self-guided or mobile friendly website walks and experience for yourself what life was like for Islanders during World War II.

This was one of the first pictures taken in Guernsey after the Liberation. It shows Peter Bott, aged 4, with his brother, trying his first ever chocolate bar and it illustrates the hardships endured by Islanders during the Occupation.

HERITAGE75

On 9 May 2020, we celebrate 75 years of Liberation.

The Channel Islands were the only part of the British Isles to be occupied during World War II, and the Islands of Guernsey lived under German control from June 1940 – May 1945. A hugely significant time in the Islands' history, there remains plenty of evidence of the Occupation to this day with coastal bunkers and military defence sites dotted across the Islands, serving as a permanent and poignant reminder.

9 May 2020 marks 75 years since the Islands' Liberation. To commemorate this special anniversary, there will be 75 unique heritage-themed events taking place between April and October, from themed tours and guided walks to exhibitions, outdoor events, and family friendly activities. So while it is always a good year to visit the Islands, 2020 will be a particularly special one.

DIVE INTO THE PAST

Our small Islands have a big history.

From our Neolithic burial ruins, thought to be one of the oldest man-made structures in Europe, our great tradition in ship building, through to the Occupation during World War II, all five Islands share a rich and varied history.

Hop to Alderney to explore the best-preserved small Roman fort in Britain, amble across to Lihou and discover the ruins of a 12th century

Benedictine priory, or set sail to Sark to hear tales of the last feudal state in Europe.

Islanders have made an impact throughout history on a global scale too. It was a Guernseyman who led the charge alongside Lord Nelson at the Battle of the Nile, a Guernseyman who defended Canada against America and a Guernseyman who even introduced coffee to the western world!

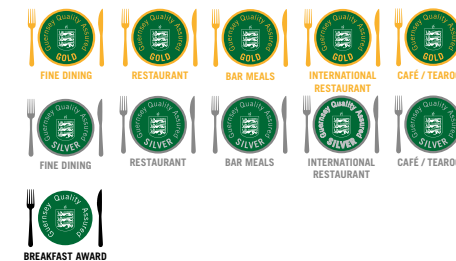

This gracious Georgian house sits atop a steep hill on the outskirts of St Peter Port. Its position ensures enviable views from its restaurant and terraces, providing an excellent base for those who wish to include a visit to Hauteville House, Victor Hugo's Guernsey residence, during their stay.

Although only a 15-minute downhill walk to the town centre, the climb back up is fairly steep, however from April to October a courtesy mini-bus operates several times daily. A complimentary afternoon tour is also offered twice weekly.


