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

2 LEARN ABOUT MULL'S MARINE WILDLIFE

The Isle of Mull is known for its natural environment and abundance of wildlife. and The Majestic Line's Around Mull: Wildlife Explorer itinerary lets you experience sightings up close. This includes a half-day tour with an awardwinning wildlife expert, whose keen eye and educational commentary will have you spotting all the beautiful creatures in the area. You'll also get to visit the Hebridean Whale & Dolphin Trust's headquarters in Tobermory to learn about its conservation work.

The focus changes with the season: spring is the best time to view nesting puffins and other seabirds on the offshore islands, and in summer, you may spot basking sharks and whales. 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
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


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6 SAIL FOR WILD SWIMMING
